Attached please find records responsive to your request for information regarding applicants and licensees.

The identities of controlling owners and principals of an applicant for a cannabis establishment license are confidential and exempt from public inspection under the Vermont Public Records Act. See [7 V.S.A. § 901\(h\)\(1\)\(A\)](#) and [7 V.S.A. § 881\(a\)\(1\)\(b\)\(i\)\(I\)](#). For that reason, the attached document does not list that information for those who have not been issued a license. That information is not confidential for those entities that have been issued licenses, as stated in [7 V.S.A. § 901\(h\)\(1\)\(B\)](#).

Nothing in this letter should be construed as a waiver of any privileges or protections over the records of the Cannabis Control Board. If you believe any records have been withheld in error, you may appeal this determination to the Chair of the Board pursuant to 1 V.S.A. § 318.
