Updated CCB Statement on Product Registration

Thank you to our licensee and applicant community for your patience as we continue to build Vermont's adult-use marketplace together.

Last week, the CCB issued a statement on product registration to update the community on our plan to migrate submissions for product registration from the interim solution to our current, salesforce-based system. Our data vendor has been working continuously both last week and this week to migrate those systems, but has not been able to complete them in the timeline previously laid out.

Our hope had been that by tomorrow, March 1st, we would be in a place to notify all applicants who submitted products for registration under the previous system of their submission status – be it granted, denied, or missing information. We will not meet that self-imposed deadline, as data migration is still ongoing.

Applicants and licensees have continued submitting product registration applications to the current system over the course of the past several days throughout the data migration process – we have received those submissions.

Staff review of product registration submissions have been paused through the migration process. We will re-start that review tomorrow, March 1st, prioritizing outstanding submissions made through the old registration system. Email notifications regarding product registration should also re-start tomorrow.

PLEASE NOTE: We are aware that some product registration communications have been filtered to applicants' spam or junk email folders. If you are waiting on communications from the CCB regarding your product registration, please be sure to check there.

As we work through this backlog, we are also compiling a list of all products that have successfully been registered with the CCB. That list will be publicly available on our website later this week.
