What is a Harvest Lot?

Harvest Lots

Harvest Lot means cannabis grown in the same manner. To meet the criteria for a single harvest lot, the given lot of cannabis would need to be on the same flowering, fertilizer, and pesticide application schedule. A single harvest lot may contain one or multiple cultivars of cannabis.

Each harvest lot will need to be tested for pesticides and pathogens.

Growers decide individually how many harvest lots they need to have. This will vary depending on what works best for a grower's individual business practice.

Harvest lot number will be your license number and a sequential number.

Ex. Harvest lot number = CLTV1234-001



Note on creating or updating Harvest Lots in Inventory Tracking:

A Harvest Lot is **created** when:

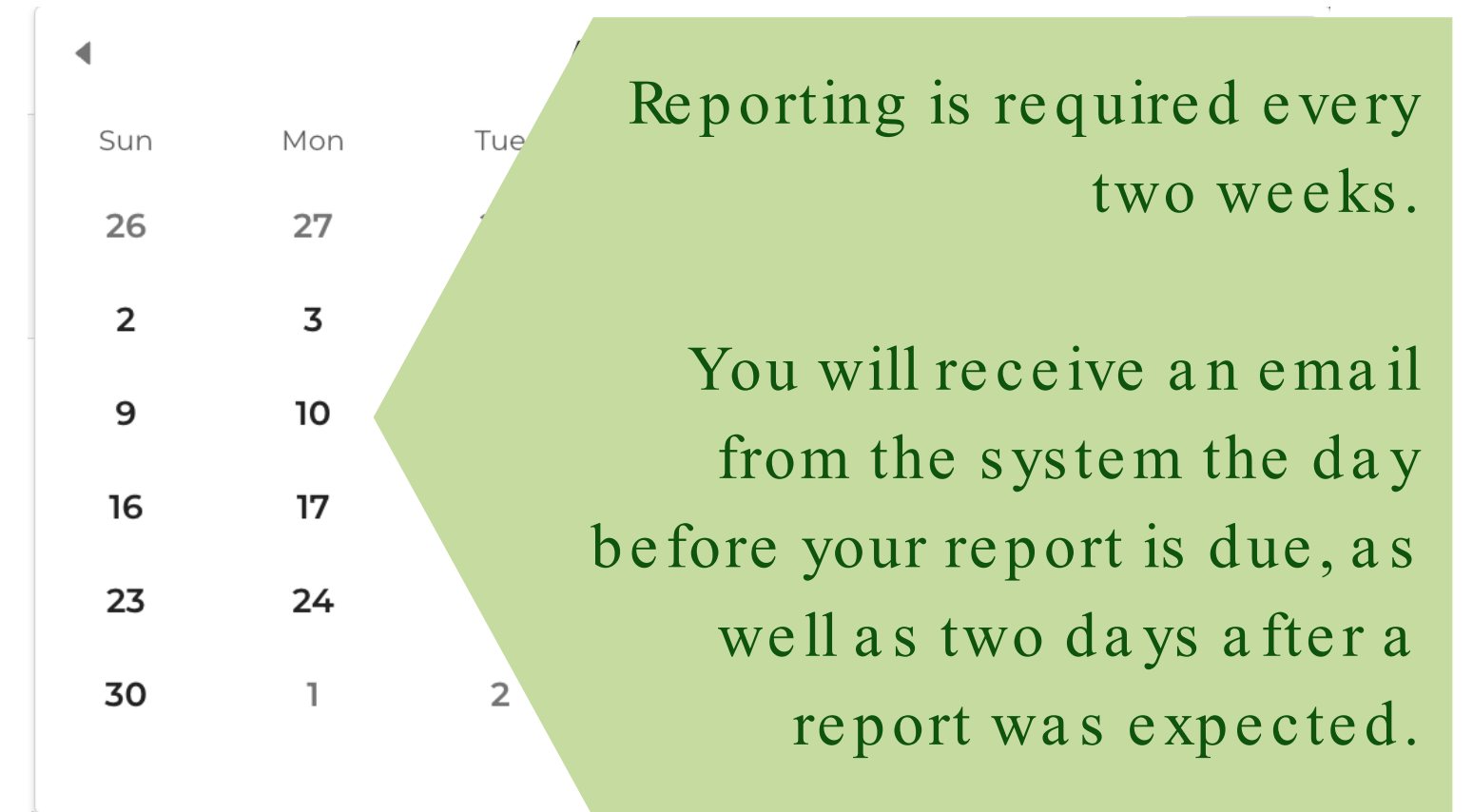
- *New plants are planted*

A Harvest Lot is **updated** when:

- *Plants have been trimmed during the growing cycle*
- *Waste has been collected during the growing cycle*
- *Plants are being cut down for processing*
 - *Capturing wet weight*
- *Other changes are made that would impact your data*

Creating a New Harvest Lot

- If a licensee misses an inventory reporting period, they must go back and submit historical data for those missing weeks.

Creating a New Harvest Lot

A Harvest Lot number of your selection must be entered each time a Harvest Lot is created.

Your Harvest Lot number will be your license number, plus a sequential number (ex: CLTV1234-001).

Harvest lot numbers cannot be re-used, and must be unique to each lot. Attempts to re-use lot numbers will result in an error message.

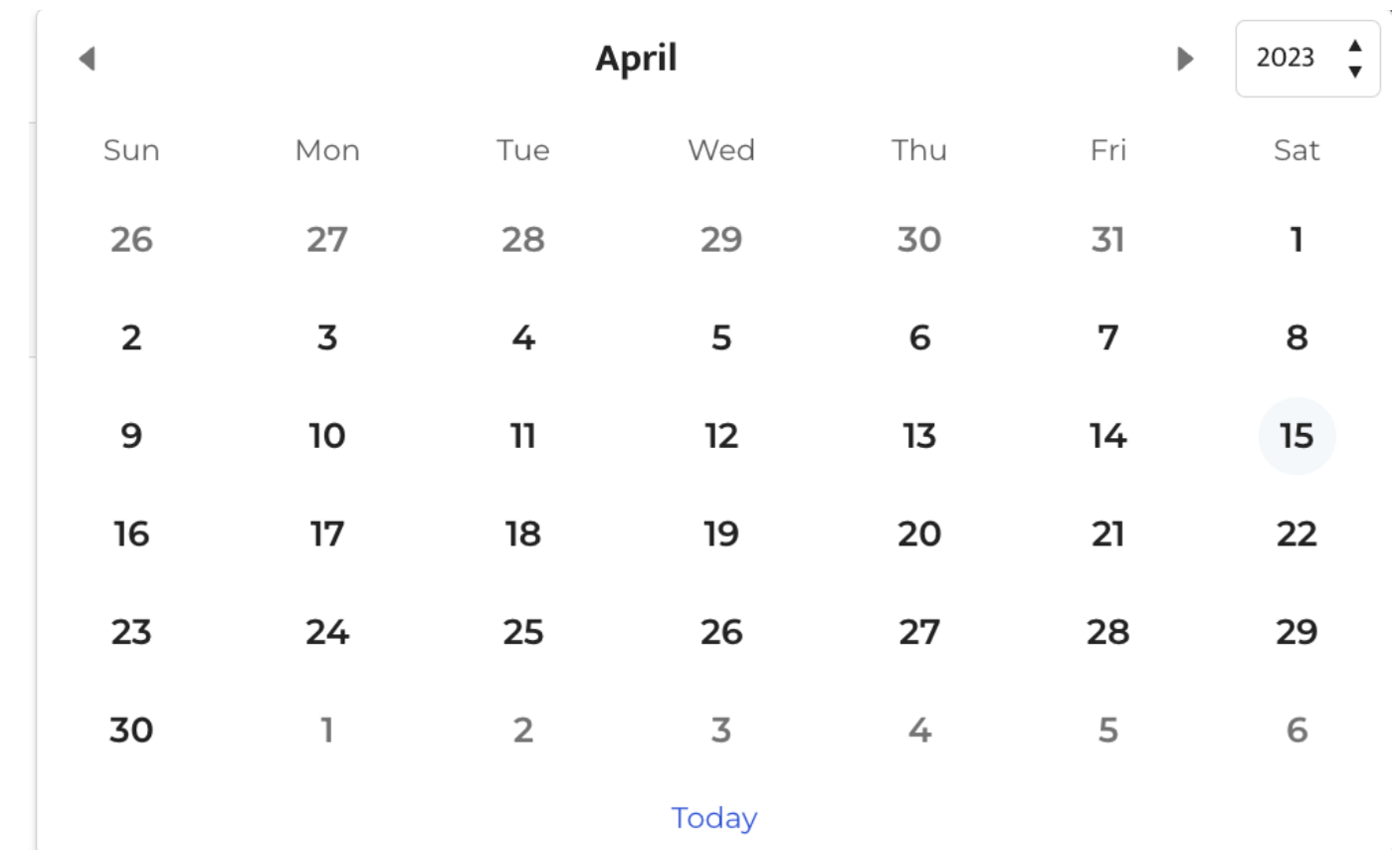

Update an Existing Harvest Lot - Important Things to Consider, Continued

- Use the Inventory Tracking ID to recall information for previous Harvest Lots. Inventory Tracking IDs are created for individual reports once they are finished.
 - More information on referencing Inventory Tracking IDs may be found on page 34 of this document.
- When an individual Harvest Lot is selected for updates, all **previously entered information should auto-populate** into the inventory tracking form to provide context for any needed updates.
- Only update fields where there have been changes from the previously entered information for the Harvest Lot. You may not need to update all fields when making changes.
 - In most cases, the planting date, growing style, whether the plants are auto-flower or photoperiod, what they were grown from, and the source of seed fields will not need to be changed.
- The Plant Count field should reflect the *current number* of plants at the time of reporting.
- Enter all weights with **ONLY** the amount captured in the two-week cycle.

Making changes in an existing Harvest Lot can be done if **something was entered in error** when the Harvest Lot was created.

Changes might also be necessary if there is **harvest activity that needs to be reported** – such as like capturing wet weight, waste weight, or updating the number of plants in the harvest.

Only enter information that occurred in the two-week reporting cycle when capturing weights.

Update an Existing Harvest Lot

Licensees will need the Inventory Tracking ID associated with the Harvest Lot in order to make changes.

Recent searched records will populate in the dropdown list. Type the Inventory Tracking ID into the search box if the desired record does not automatically appear.

To find Inventory Tracking IDs, and the records linked to them, navigate to 'My Inventory Tracking Reports' on the side panel of the licensing portal.

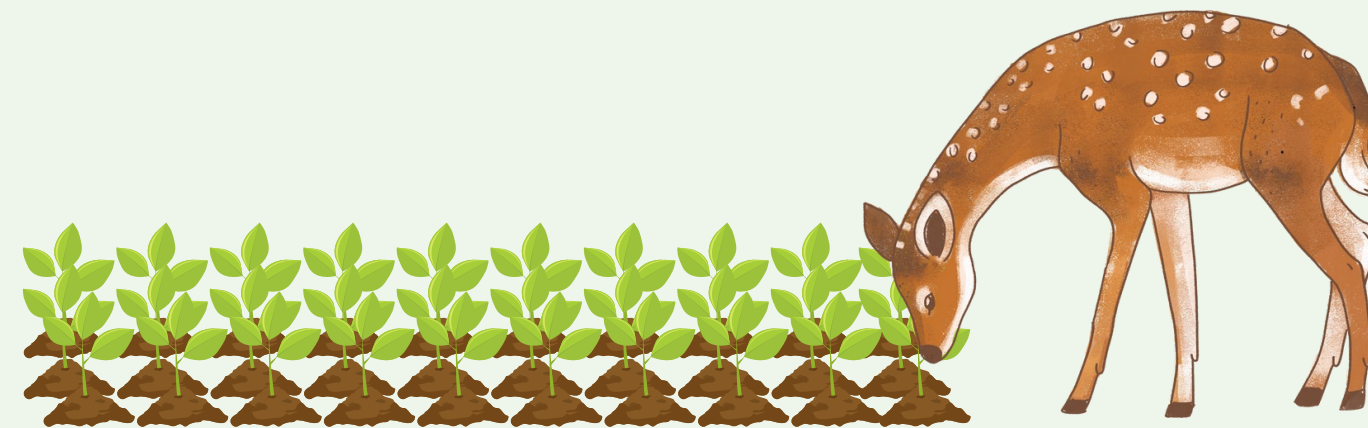

Updating Weight Information

Initial previously recorded weights will populate.

When updating the weight information for a Harvest Lot, DO NOT submit cumulative values.

Remove the initial value previously entered onto the form - ONLY submit the weight captured during the two-week reporting cycle.

The CCB system will store all previously recorded values. Failure to result in reporting this way may cause inflated or duplicate values.

What is a Process Lot?

Process Lots

Process lots are whole or partial harvest lots that follow different paths toward market or diverted into waste. For example – a single harvest lot would be broken into two process lots if half was sold fresh frozen to a manufacturer, and half was dried, cured, and sold as bulk flower to a retailer.

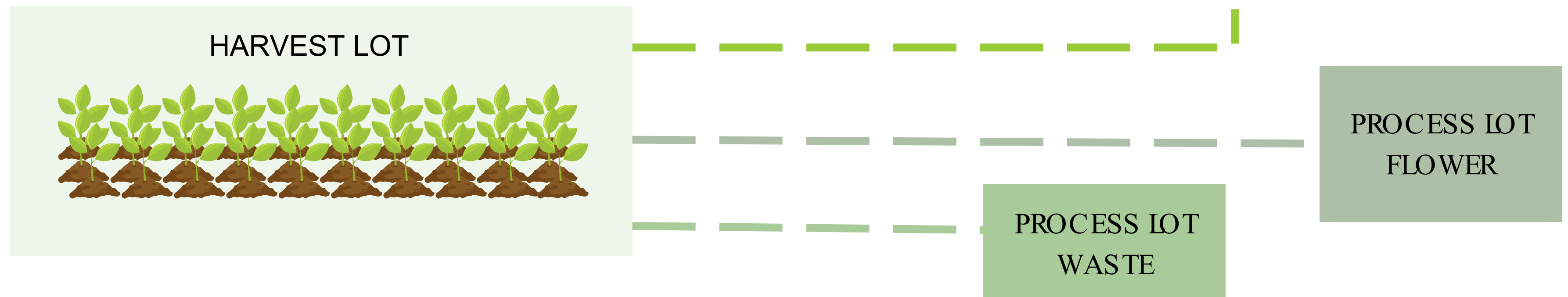
Process Lot numbers are the harvest lot number with an additional sequential number.

Ex. Process lot number = LIC1234-001-001

Notes on Testing for Process Lots

Process lots of smokable flower will need to be tested for THC potency and pathogens. The moisture analysis will be part of this testing. Flower for retail sales must be at or below 30% THC content.

Cannabis flower that tests positive for Aspergillus cannot enter the market as a smokable product. It may, however, be used for extraction purposes.

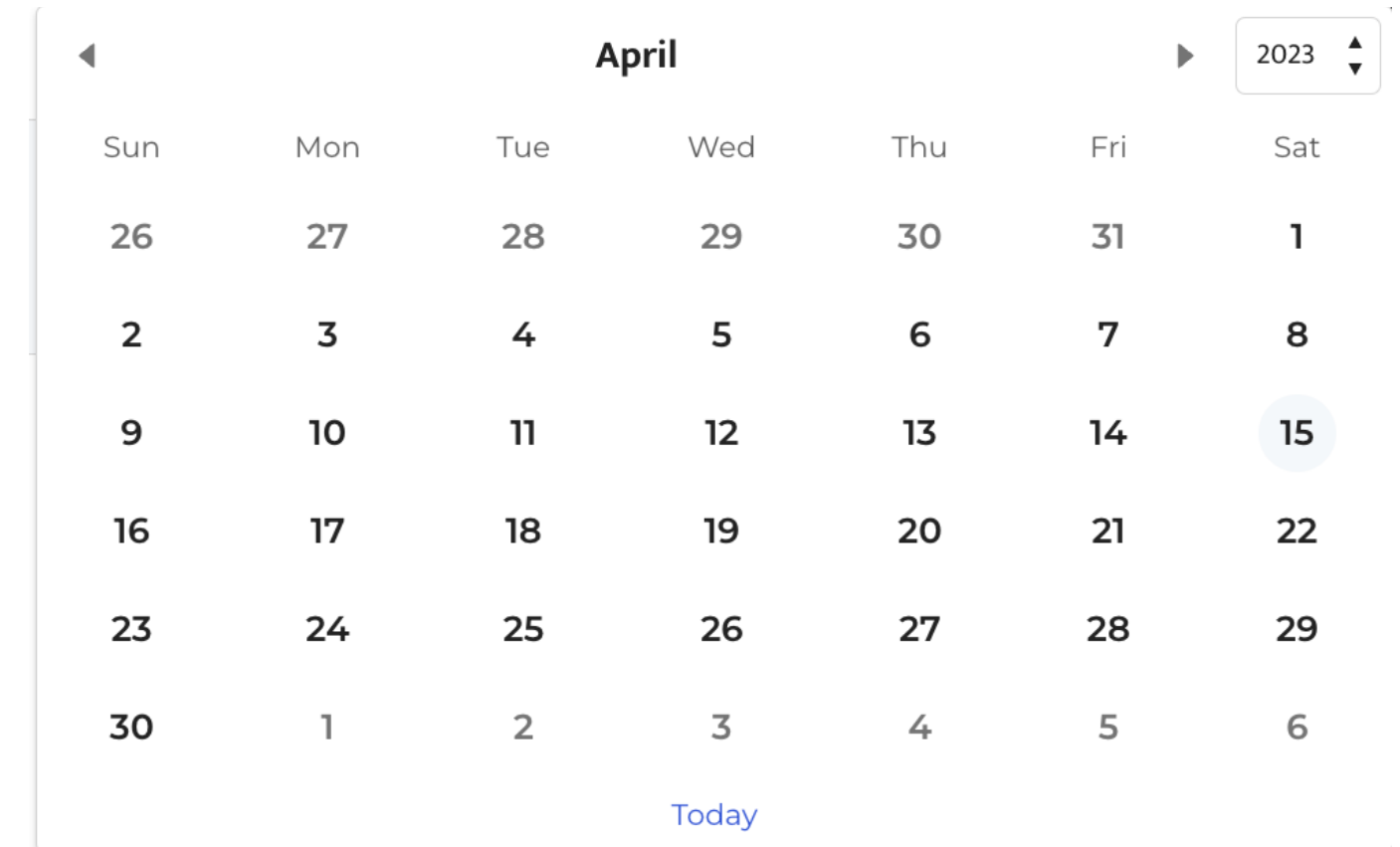
